

Call for Proposals: The Robert Lamberton and Susan Rotroff Fund in Classics

The Robert Lamberton and Susan Rotroff Fund in Classics supports any form of summer study by undergraduate or graduate students in the Department of Classics, or by undergraduate or graduate students in the Department of Art History and Archaeology whose primary interest is in ancient Greece and/or Rome. Activities to be supported by this fund include but are not limited to the following:

Participation in the Summer School of the American Academy in Rome or the American School of Classical Studies in Athens.

Participation in an archaeological excavation.

Travel to an academic conference

Special summer language study in the United States or abroad not available at Washington University.

Travel for individual research to libraries in the United States or abroad.

If you are planning activity of this nature this summer and wish to apply for funding from this fund, please submit a proposal of no more than three pages as an email attachment (Word or pdf) to Timothy Moore (tmooore26@wustl.edu) by April 15, 2016. The proposal should include the following:

1. A description of your plans and how they will contribute to your education and/or to your research goals.
2. A short budget summary. This should include justification for any travel and other costs related to your plans.
3. A description of any other sources of funding you have received for your summer plans.
